Charles Taker, a seasoned practitioner with over 25 years of experience in faith education, including the last 15 years coordinating the RCIA process at St. Patrick's Basilica, will provide a hands-on session especially geared towards new members of parish RCIA teams. This three-hour session, given in English, will explore the adult initiation process, provide an overview of the ritual book* and discuss pastoral issues and practical applications.
