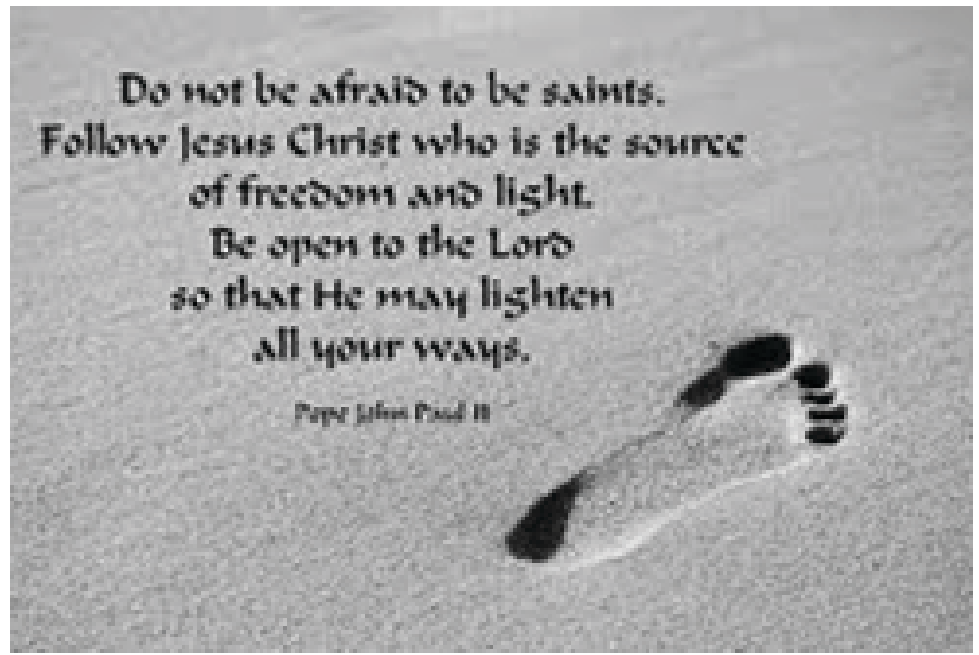

The fish in the story represent all the people who will be found for Christ. And he'd say to Peter, 'look at the fish and think of the people and know that I am 'alive'.

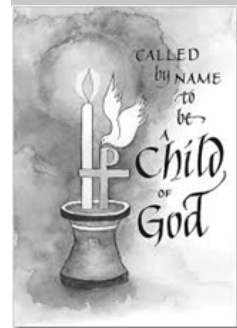

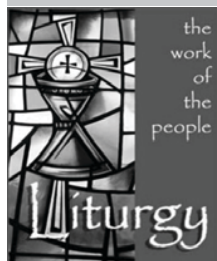
PRE-ARRANGED FUNERAL MASS AT THE CHURCH
