Decalogue Eight

Do Not Lie



The dark suffering and struggle of two women that has spanned more than forty-five years comes dramatically to the light in this magnificent tale of confrontation and reconciliation. The elder woman, now a renowned university professor of ethics, during the Nazi occupation refused to help a little Jewish girl, allegedly because she didn't want to have to tell a lie. This and other falsehoods and half-truths have strongly influenced the lives of the two women. In the present time of the film, the women meet, and two moments of violent confrontation lead to confessions and truth-telling. In the end, the hospitality denied forty-five years before is graciously offered and accepted, in what is perhaps the most touching and satisfying conclusion in the *Decalogue* series.
