Diocesan Triduum for the Feast of Christ, King of the Universe

Montreal, November 20, 2018 – The celebration of the Solemnity of Christ, King of the Universe – the crowning of the liturgical year – holds high significance for Most Rev. Christian Lépine, Archbishop of Montreal. He, therefore, invites all members of the diocesan community to join him at Mary Queen of the World Cathedral for the Triduum that will be held for this great feast.

Friday, November 23 at 8 a.m.: **Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament** begins (Exposition continues until the 7:30 p.m. Mass the following day, November 24.)

Friday, November 23 at 7:30 p.m.: **Evening Prayer led by Mission Jeunesse Youth Ministry.** The evening will highlight two missions: the sending of pilgrims to the upcoming World Youth Day in Panama and the sending of youth leaders out on mission in the diocese.

Saturday, November 24 at 7:30 p.m.: **Solemn Mass for the Feast of Christ the King,** celebrated by the archbishop

For Archbishop Christian Lépine, this feast has a unique character: "It is the synthesis of the Mystery of Salvation, the Paschal Mystery of death and resurrection. It is the journey of Jesus Christ who entered the world and who rose from the dead. He became Master of the history of humanity. I invite all the faithful, anyone who seeks Jesus Christ, to welcome the King of the universe into their own life history."

Christ is at the centre, Christ is the centre: the Centre of creation, the Centre of humanity, the Centre of history. Jesus is the centre of our desire for joy and salvation. Let's journey together along this road!
