Marriage Preparation

The *Diocesan Centre for Marriage, Life and Family* reaches out not only to couples who are seeking formation in preparation for their marriage, but also to priests and pastoral team members looking for resources in order to help better accompany couples who come to them for support.

We publish an **annual booklet** containing information of practical use for couples and for any association offering marriage preparation in the Diocese of Montreal. This year, we have distributed **over 1,000 booklets** throughout our parishes.

We have **extended our program** in order to allow couples to take more time to work together and really digest the material. Instead of meeting for one intensive weekend, they had eight meetings in one month that lasted three hours each.

Couples had an overall positive reaction to this change, which gave them more time for dialogue and to formulate questions. They also came to know each other and the volunteer mentor couples better. Once the course was finished, they came away with a new **sense of belonging** to the Church.
