2018-2019 PASTORAL YEAR



The chancery team would like to introduce the *Pastoral and Missionary Vitality Profile*, a newly-amended document to succeed the more commonly-known annual *Pastoral Report*.

The Presbyteral Council, the Episcopal Council and the diocesan network of Offices and Services contributed their insights and counsel at each stage of the development of this document. We hope that it will serve not only as a tool for gathering helpful information, but will also prove useful to parishes and missions. While there are many flavours of vitality, the purpose of this *Profile* is to concentrate on parish and mission vitality in order to:

1. Provide a complementary tool for the mission:

This tool does not claim to be perfect. We hope that it will be a complementary tool.

2. Offer a tool that focuses on practices:

You will find a list of different practical activities that parishes and missions can implement. While we encourage discussion on the theological meaning of parish and mission vocation, the *Profile* focuses more on a list of practical activities.

3. Promote your ideas for activities:

Another objective with this *Profile* is to encourage you to put forward your ideas so that the list of activities of the Archdiocese of Montreal's *Pastoral and Missionary Vitality Profile* grows from year to year. As this *Profile* does not contain open-ended questions, your ideas may be added at the end of each sub-section under "Other activities".

4. Invite each parish and mission to **see themselves** in their baptismal vocation as lived by Jesus Christ: Priest, Prophet and King:

The three offices of Priest, Prophet and King encompass all areas of ministry: prayer, liturgy, evangelization of non-Catholics, pastoral activity, services to parishioners, service to society, and more, allowing everyone to see themselves through these complementary aspects of mission.

5. ...on mission with Jesus Christ:

The final section of the *Profile* directs the parishes and missions towards action. Based on the specificity of your neighbourhood, you are invited to describe your dreams for your parishes and missions as well as actions inspired by this *Profile*.

6. **Together** on mission with Jesus Christ:

We recommend filling out the *Profile* together with your pastoral team and even as a collaboration with the fellow priests of your missionary territory, to encourage shared involvement with respect to individual charisms and the reality of the local neighbourhood. Moreover, involving people in missionary activities will help with evangelization and making missionary disciples at the service of God.

May the Lord, who inspired this *Profile*, guide you in your ministry.
