This diocesan recognition aligns with the following goals:

- **To highlight** the important contribution of an organization or an individual towards world transformation, having listened to the joys and struggles of the people.
- **To encourage** members of the Diocese to become involved in outreach, particularly in areas of Christian and civilian community life, such as: faith education; receiving migrants and refugees;

care and concern for the elderly, the sick and isolated people; safeguarding our common home, etc.
