

COMMUNIQUÉ No. 96 – FEBRUARY 2, 2024 INFORMATION AND REMINDER

To Members of Parish Teams, To our Clergy, PCLs, and LPAs, To the faithful active in their communities, To Members of Religious Communities, To Archdiocesan Staff,

Dear brothers and sisters, Lent is already upon us. I wish you a good start to this month of February full of Church events!

1. <u>RCIA</u>

As you are no doubt aware, the Archdiocese's financial difficulties have led to a reduction in the number of staff in the Diocesan Services and, as a result, a reorganization of our activities, particularly with regard to the Evangelization and Christian Life Service. In this context, here is some important news concerning the **RCIA Service**:

A) Following the temporary reorganization of our services and activities, this year the Cathedral's pastoral team will assume responsibility for the three celebrations associated with the RCIA:

- 1. Sunday February 18, 2024 from 2:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the Cathedral, celebrated by Archbishop Christian Lépine: **RITE OF ELECTION**;
- 2. Sunday, March 17th, 2024 from 2:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the Cathedral, celebrated by Archbishop Christian Lépine:: CALL FOR ADULT CONFIRMANDS;
- Sunday at the beginning of October 2024 from 2:30 to 4:30 p.m. (date to be confirmed) at the Cathedral, celebrated by Archbishop Christian Lépine: MASS FOR NEOPHYTES AND FIRST YEARS OF ADULT BAPTISM.
- **B**) This is the new procedure for sending information to the Chancery office:

An official e-mail from the **parish priest** only (this would replace the parish priest's official signature) with the **following information**:

- For the **RITE OF ELECTION**: last name and first name of the catechumen, name of parish and baptism date
- For an **ADULT CONFIRMATION**: last name and first name of the person to be confirmed, name of parish and planned date of confirmation

- For an **ENTRY INTO FULL COMMUNION**: first name and last name of the person, former religion of the person, name of the parish and planned date of entry into full communion

- Please note that the Office for Faith Education and the Chancery office no longer need to receive the five forms (B-1 to B-5)

We understand that these changes can present challenges, and we are grateful for your flexibility and commitment to the spiritual well-being of our diocese.

Despite the many challenges that lie ahead, I want to emphasize that the RCIA program remains an important part of our diocesan life. While some temporary adjustments have been necessary due to layoffs, I want to assure you that we are actively working to reorganize all Catechumenate and RICA initiatives.

2. World Day for Consecrated Life

On the occasion of World Day for Consecrated Life, which takes place every year on February 02, feast of the Presentation of the Lord at the Temple, a Eucharistic celebration will be presided by Archbishop Christian Lépine, on **Saturday February 3, at 10:30 a.m.**, at the Cathédrale Marie-Reine-Du-Monde, 1085 Rue de la Cathédrale, Montréal QC H3B 2V4, under the theme: "Consecrated life at the service of society".
