



Called home to the Father, R.I.P.

Brouillette, Jean 1945 – 2020

Father Jean Brouillette has passed away at the age of 75 on October 1, 2020 in Montreal. Ordained in 1973, Father Brouillette was parochial vicar for the parish of Saint-Stanislas de Kostka for several years. He also performed the pastoral ministry at Notre-Dame and Jean Talon hospitals, and later was pastor to the parishes of Saint-Barthélemy and Saint-Matthieu. Thereafter he was priest-collaborator at Notre-Dame Cathedral and for the parish of Saint-Esprit in Rosemont. He had been retired for about five years, having been prevented by illness from actively carrying out his presbyteral ministry.

The closed casket will be on view Friday, October 9 between two and five o'clock p.m. at the J.A. Guilbault funeral complex at 5359 Saint-Michel Blvd. The funeral mass will be held the following day, Saturday, October 10 (11:00) at the Saint-Jean-Vianney Parish at 6421 25e Avenue, Montreal. Following cremation, the ashes will be interred at a private ceremony on Wednesday, October 21 at Notre-Dame-des-Neiges cemetery.
