One of our former volunteers, Angie Gugliotti from Missione Maria Ausiliatrice in R.D.P., wrote to tell us of a creative project to touch the lives of seniors in her community. In her words:

"We wanted to share a new initiative that we started at the parish. For five months, from May to September, we held a 45-minute spiritual walk in our neighborhood, reciting the rosary and visiting different parishioners outside their homes. We would stop outside each home and recite part of the rosary for 2-3 minutes before moving on.

During those five months, every Saturday morning, we touched many lives. We visited frail elderly parishioners who can no longer attend church, as well as those who are sick and suffering from illness, and grieving families. What began as a spiritual walking group developed into a ministry that aligns with some of SASMAD's goals.

We wanted to share this with you because it's a new initiative that thinks outside the box in how we can reach our frail, sick, and grieving parishioners and provide them with comfort.

I have personally grown so much from this experience, and so have others. I wanted to share it with you because it offers a different perspective on visiting parishioners—one that is truly enlightening. We will be continuing this new ministry next summer, and people in our community are looking forward to it."
