

TESTAMENTARY CLAUSES - EXAMPLES

SPECIFIC BEQUEST

-Specific amount

“I bequeath to the *Corporation Archiépiscope Catholique Romaine de Montréal*, charity registration number 118876390RR0001, the sum of \$*_specify amount_*, in support of its mission.”

-Specific property or asset

“I bequeath to the *Corporation Archiépiscope Catholique Romaine de Montréal*, charity registration number 118876390RR0001, my property located at *_specify address_*, in support of its mission”.

UNIVERSAL BEQUEST (the entirety of the property)

“I bequeath all of the movable and immovable property that I shall possess at the time of my death, including the proceeds of any life insurance policy not bearing a named beneficiary, to the *Corporation Archiépiscope Catholique Romaine de Montréal*, charity registration number 118876390RR0001, in support of its mission.”

RESIDUAL BEQUEST (all or a portion of the remainder of the property following payment of debts and specific bequests)

“I bequeath the entire residue of my movable and immovable property, including the proceeds of any life insurance policy not bearing a named beneficiary, to the *Corporation Archiépiscope Catholique Romaine de Montréal*, registered charity number 118876390RR0001, in support of its mission.”

CONTINGENT BEQUEST (in the event of the death of the primary beneficiary)

“I bequeath to X all my movable and immovable property, including the proceeds of any life insurance policy not bearing a named beneficiary.

If X should predecease me or die at the same time or within thirty (30) days following my death, or if he/she should disclaim this bequest or be unable to receive it lawfully, I bequeath all my aforesaid movable and immovable property to the *Corporation Archiépiscope Catholique Romaine de Montréal*, registered charity number 118876390RR0001, for its mission.”
